CVF Director's Walk

PT200 Penticton KVR Walk – 6 and 10 km – rated 1B



The walk begins at 553 Veas Drive (corner of Veas Drive and Eckhardt Ave W). The Penticton Wine Country Visitor Centre (with washrooms) and plenty of parking are nearby.

1. From the corner of Veas and Eckhardt, walk out to Eckhardt Ave., turn left and cross Veas Drive at traffic lights.
 2. Continue on Eckardt Ave. crossing Winnipeg St (0.8 km) and Main St.
 3. Immediately after crossing Haywood St, turn **left** onto paved trail (1.7 km). This is part of the old Kettle Valley Railway. Continue on trail crossing a number of streets to reach Vancouver Ave (2.8 km).
- 6 km walkers turn left on Vancouver Ave and continue at instruction 7*
4. Cross Vancouver Ave and continue straight onto Vancouver Place. **Right** on gravel trail after house number 144 (3.0 km)
 5. Continue straight on gravel trail with nice views of Okanagan Lake and the city. Continue on the gravel trail to the large rocks at the cemetery and turn around. (Washrooms are available up concrete steps a little further on the trail if needed).
 6. Return on same trail to Vancouver Place and Vancouver Ave. **Right** on Vancouver Ave (stop sign) (6.6 km).
 7. Go down the hill. **Right** at roundabout on Ellis St. to go towards the Art Gallery of the South Okanagan. Pass the Gallery. **Left** on path just before Penticton Ikeda Japanese Garden Sign (7.3 km)
 8. Follow the path over a wooden bridge. **Right** on paved path after the bridge and continue on path veering to the left to follow the lakeshore (water on your right).
 9. **Left** at flagpoles to continue along lakeshore. Follow path as it curves right passing Water Sports Rentals and continues along lakeshore.
 10. **Right** on Lakeshore Dr W keeping along lakeshore. **Left** on Power St (Convention Centre Visitor Sign on post). (8.8 km)
 11. **Follow** Power St and Veas Drive to return to the start point (9.8 km).
