



Volkssport Association of British Columbia CVF Director's Walk



PT257 Salmon Arm –5/10km – Rated 2B

The trail begins at the parking lot across the road from the Marine Plaza building at 781 Marine Park Dr V1E 4P1. The parking lot is pay parking but very cheap. Washrooms are available. From Hwy 1 turn north (towards the lake) on Shuswap St N, right on Lakeshore Dr NW, left on Marine Park Drive.

1. Turn left (south) from the parking lot on Marine Park Drive, and turn right on Harbour Front Drive NE to walk on the road past Prestige Harbourfront Resort.
2. At paved path, turn right and follow along water front (nesting place of the Western Grebe).
3. At road (Marine Park Drive), turn left and follow road to end of wharf, (longest fresh water wharf in Canada). Turn around and follow back to where you entered the road and turn left, follow path around parking lot.
4. Turn left at raised walkway and follow to end. (2.1 km)
5. Turn left at road. At the end of the road, continue straight ahead on gravel road and then straight on the path into the Nature Bay Wildlife Sanctuary (washrooms). (2.7 km)
6. Turn left at the first trail (a raised wooden walkway) to Viewing Platform #1. Return to main trail and turn left. (3.2 km)
7. Turn left at the next trail. Follow the gravel path to Christmas Island. Return to main trail. (3.7 km)
8. **If doing the 5 km walk, turn right and return to the start point. (5.2 km)**
9. **For the 10 km route, turn left and continue on the path.**
10. Turn left at the next trail, and follow the raised path to Viewing Platform #2. Return to main trail and turn left. (4.1 km)
11. Trail passes along a raised walkway.
13. Just after a Nature Bay Wildlife Sanctuary sign, the trail ends at a fence, gate and road. (6.0 km)
14. Turn around and retrace the main path back to the start point. (10.0 km)

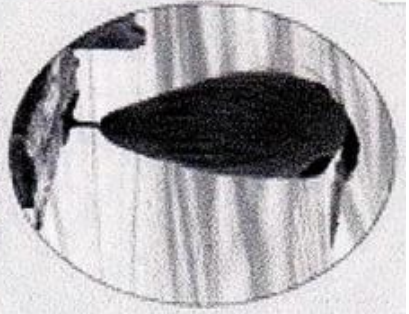

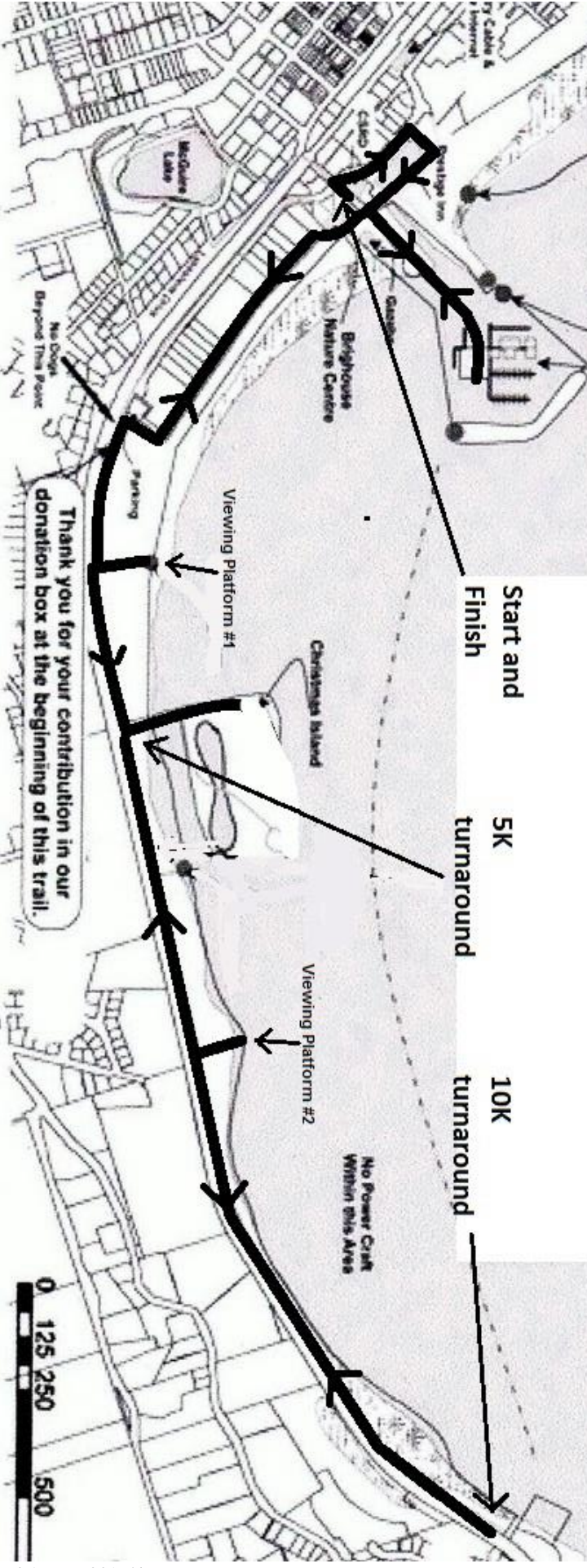
