



Volkssport Association of British Columbia CVF Director's Walk



PT259 Okanagan Falls – 5/11 km – Rated 1B

The walk begins at the Okanagan Falls Visitor Centre which is now located on the north side of Highway 97 (9th Ave), just to the west of the IGA store. If you are entering OK Falls from the north it will be on the left side of the road just after crossing the bridge. If entering from the south it will be on the right side of the road just after passing IGA. The Visitor Centre is open Mon – Fri all year and weekends in summer. Washrooms are available inside the Visitor Centre and in Kiwanis Park behind the Visitor Centre.

1. Exit Visitor Centre and turn left. At Cedar Street, cross over Highway 97 at the crosswalk and turn left to continue along Highway 97.
 2. Highway 97 turns right (Main Street) and passes Caitlin's Café and Bakery which offers good food, coffee and washrooms for customers. Turn right on Veteran's Way (12th Ave).
 3. Turn right at Ash Street. Turn left at 11th Ave and pass the OK Falls Elementary School and then turn right on Cedar Street.
 4. Cross 9th Ave (Hwy 97) at crosswalk (1.4 km). Continue on Cedar Street and turn left on 8th Ave. Washrooms are on your right in Kenyon Park. Turn right at Railway Lane then left on a paved path through Lions Gardens.
 5. Turn right on trail and cross over wooden trestle on gravel Kettle Valley Railway Trail.
- 5 km walkers look for a log house on the right side of the trail, behind a chain link fence. At this point, turn around and return to the start point.*
6. **10 km walkers** continue on trail along the shore of Skaha Lake.
 7. **Just after** passing Ponderosa Point Resort on your right, turn left on Ponderosa Ave (unsigned – just before resort office) to Kaledon Pioneer Park (washrooms open in summer). (6 km)
 8. **TURN AROUND** at Kaledon Pioneer Park and follow route back to Highway 97 and the Visitor Centre.
