



Volkssporting Association of British Columbia CVF Director's Walk



PT302 Keremeos – 12 km – Rated 1B

The walk begins at the Keremeos Visitor Centre located at 417-7th Ave (V0X 1N0) at the corner of 4th St. The Visitor Centre is open Monday to Friday year round. Parking and washrooms are available.

1. Exit the Visitor Centre and turn left on 4th Street. (9 km)
2. Pass Veterans Ave and under the hydro lines. Turn right around a concrete barrier – you are now on the rail bed (built by the Vancouver, Victoria and Eastern Railway – a subsidiary of the Great Northern Railway).
3. Follow the rail bed, past the turkey farm, all the way to the Ashnola River Road. Left to the covered “Red Bridge”.
4. Cross over the bridge and follow the Ashnola River Road a short distance to River Road. (5 km)
5. Left on River Road and left onto Bridge Street. (9 km)
6. Right on 10th Avenue to 2nd Street. Right on 2nd St. Where 2nd St. bends to the left, continue straight up a short gravel path to the Village Promenade dyke alongside the river.
7. Turn left (eastbound) along the Promenade/Dyke trail until you come to a park on your left (11 km)
8. Walk across the park (washrooms) to the road (12th Avenue) and turn right. Turn left on 7th Street.
9. Continue on 7th Street to 7th Avenue. Turn left passing the Cenotaph on your left and return to the Visitor Centre. (12.2 km)
