CVF Director's Walk YRE 303 Mayne Island - 6K/9K/12K/15K/18K - Rated 3B



The walk begins at the Mayne Island Ferry Terminal at Village Bay (washrooms and coffee shop in summer). Check <http://www.bcferries.com> for times of ferries from Vancouver (Tsawwassen) or Victoria (Swartz Bay)

12K Route (allow 3-4 hours)

1. Keep to the left as you walk up the hill from the Ferry Terminal
2. Turn right along Village Bay Road.
3. Turn left along Fernhill Rd towards Miners Bay (3K)
4. Turn right along Georgina Point Road.
5. At intersection of Georgina Point and Waugh Roads, veer left on Georgina Point Road. Follow paved road to lighthouse. (6K)
6. Retrace route to Ferry Terminal.

15K Route (allow 4-5 hours)

1. Keep to the left as you walk up the hill from the Ferry Terminal
2. Turn right along Village Bay Road.
3. Turn left along Fernhill Rd towards Miners Bay. (3K)
4. Turn right along Georgina Point Road.
5. Turn left at intersection of Georgina Pt and Waugh Roads. Follow paved road to lighthouse. (6K)
6. Proceed back along Georgina Point Road.
7. Turn left along Waugh Road.
8. Turn right along Campbell Bay Road.
9. Turn right along Fernhill Road. (11K)
10. Turn left along Village Bay Road to Ferry Terminal.

Optional additional 3K loop (allow at least 1 hour)

1. Keep to the left as you walk up the hill from the Ferry Terminal. Turn right along Dalton Drive.
2. Veer right on Dalton at intersection with Merryman Drive and go uphill to intersection with Mariners Way. Turn right and then almost immediately turn left on Dinner Bay Road (0.7K).
3. Turn left on Dinner Bay Road at intersection with Spinnaker Drive. Pass Lundy Lane and East West Road.
4. At intersection with Leighton Lane you will see a sign 'Ed Williams Memorial Trail Japanese Garden 600 mtrs'. Turn right onto the trail (it's a bit overgrown at first) and follow trail through woods until you reach a playground/picnic area.
5. Turn right and follow gravelly trail around the bay.

Don't go under pink tape but pass to the left of it to a wire fence. Turn left and follow the fence. Path then veers left away from the fence. Turn right under an arch to enter the Japanese Garden.

6. Go through the deer gate (1.5K). Veer left and then turn right at 'T' junction. Go under an arch and then right around the pond. Just before reaching a fence, turn left over a bridge, round the pond and under an arch to the 'Secret Garden'.
7. Go past the bell, turn right and return through the deer gate. Go straight, back under the first arch, and straight past 3 white buildings to a paved road.
8. Turn right on road and then turn left on Dinner Bay Road (unsigned) up hill and back past Leighton Lane, East West Road and Lundy Lane.
9. Turn right on Dinner Bay Road at intersection with Spinnaker. Turn right on Mariners Way and then immediately turn left on Dalton and return to the Ferry Terminal (3.3K)

9K Route (allow 2-3 hours)

1. First do the "optional additional 3K loop" and return to the Ferry Terminal (3K)
2. Turn right along Village Bay Road and walk to the village of Miners Bay (6K)
3. Retrace route to Ferry Terminal (9K)

6K Route

1. Keep to the left as you walk up the hill from the ferry
2. Turn right along Village Bay Road and walk to the village of Miner's Bay (3K)
3. Retrace route to Ferry Terminal (6K)

- washroom in park at side of library
- Springwater Lodge & Pub (built in 1892)
- Bakery/shops

Georgina Point Heritage Park and Lighthouse

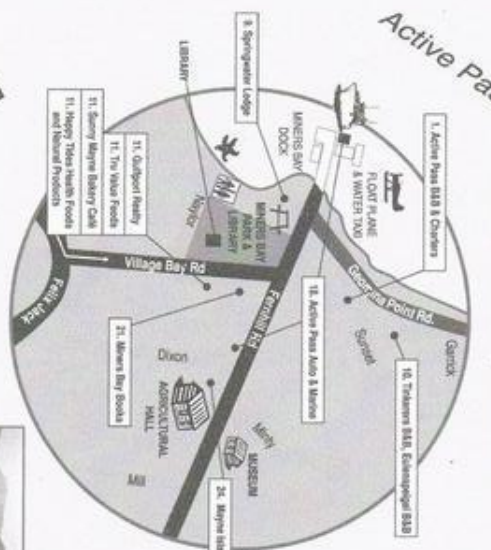
- washroom, picnic tables
